LEADERship MARTIN COUNTY

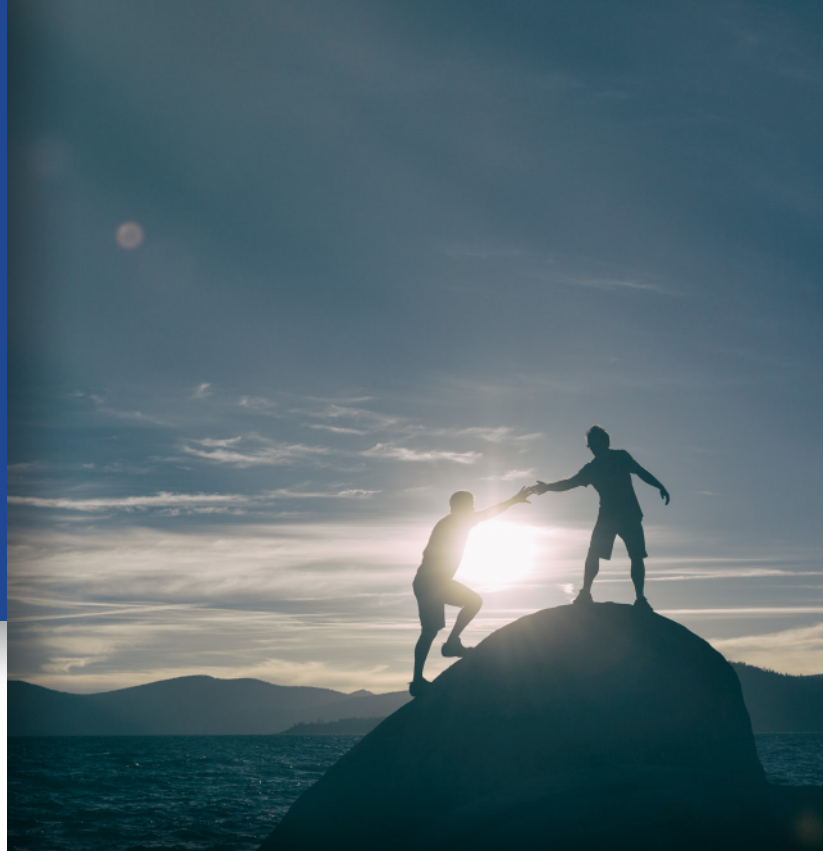
